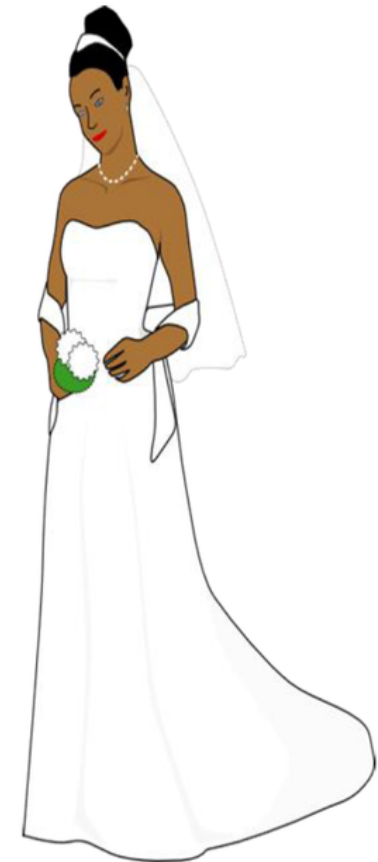

## **How Do I Plan My Wedding at Mt. Pisgah A M.E. Church?**

Please call the church office at (201) 435-3680, Tuesday –Thursday, 9:00 am – 3:00 pm, to schedule an appointment with the Pastor.

You are required to complete six to eight (6-8) pre-marital counseling sessions. Upon completion of your counseling sessions we look forward to your wedding ceremony.

## **May I Tour the Church?**

You may contact the church office to schedule an appointment to view the pertinent areas of the church.

## **Must I be a Member of Mt. Pisgah A.M.E. Church?**

You need not be a member of Mt. Pisgah A.M.E. Church to hold your wedding ceremony here. However, as a Christian congregation, Mt. Pisgah reserves the right to refrain from accepting applicants who request marriages that conflict with the ethics of our faith as based on the Bible.

## **Is Pre-Marital Counseling A Pre-Requisite?**

Our church holds to the policy that pre-marital counseling helps the engaged couple build a stronger marriage because of the information taught and the subsequent bonding that transpires between the couple. Consequently, all couples desiring to wed at Mt. Pisgah A.M.E. Church must complete the counseling sessions.
